Overview:

Situated along the Gulf of Mexico, Okaloosa County is comprised of a little more than 600,000 acres with the Eglin Air Force Base Reservation covering 240,000 of those acres. Okaloosa County's population is over 192,000 and around 60,000 of those are directly affiliated with the armed forces.

Job Description:

Enforces all laws and ordinances, policies and procedures in support of the Airport Security Programs and public safety at the three county airports.

Minimum Requirements:

Requires a high school diploma or GED; supplemented by a minimum of one (1) year of experience in law enforcement work; or an equivalent combination of education, training and experience. Experience in airport security activities at a commercial service airport subject to 49 CFR Part 1542 is preferred. Must meet statutory requirements as outlined in sections 943.13 F.S. (Officers' minimum qualifications for employment or appointment) and 943.135 F.S. (Requirements for continued employment). Requires a valid driver license.
