

## **AIRPORT POLICE CHIEF**

Piedmont Triad Airport Authority

Position performs comprehensive managerial, administrative, and specialized law enforcement work directing the activities of the Police, K-9, and Badging and Records Divisions of the airport.

- ? Position oversees the work and training of civilian and sworn personnel for the department.
- ? Position supervises the preparation of annual budget and recommends to the Director of Operations.
- ? Position receives and investigates inquiries or complaints from the public concerning police activities and services.
- ? Position supervises all departmental personnel through subordinate supervisors; establishes policy; sets priorities; and evaluates both the department and personnel.
- ? Position fosters professional development within the Department and maintains effective communications at all levels within the department.
- ? Position supervises the preparation of crime and accident reports; reviews police activity in relation to the reports; and analyzes data for trends.
- ? Position works with the public and/or other law enforcement agencies on difficult or unusual crime situations; and cooperates with these agencies in crime prevention, detection, and investigation as needed.
- ? Position serves as the alternate Airport Security Coordinator as needed; monitors provisions related to airport safety and operations as required by the TSA; and administers security directives with airport tenants, employees, contractors, passengers, etc.
- ? Position is responsible for the establishment, communication, and adherence of Departmental policies and procedures; is responsible for adherence to the mission of the Department; and is responsible for compliance with applicable FAA and TSA regulations.
- ? Position develops and implements emergency response plans and oversees adherence to these plans in emergency situations.
- ? Position conducts Secure Identification Display Area (SIDA) training as mandated by the TSA.
- ? Position, when needed, supervises routine patrol; performs essential job duties of all departmental personnel; and performs other related duties as required.

Minimum requirements include graduation from an accredited college or university with a bachelor's degree in Criminal Justice or Public Administration, supplemented by basic and advanced courses in police science and administration. Extensive experience in police work along with related managerial and administrative work experience is also required. A valid North Carolina driver's license and completion of the minimum qualifications established by the North Carolina Criminal Justice Training and Standards Council for certified law enforcement officers or the ability to obtain within one year is needed. Thorough knowledge of and experience in working with FAA and TSA

regulations, specifically FAR Part 139 and 49 CFR Parts 1540 and 1542 also are required. Experience working with the TSA and Customs and Border Patrol is desired.

Additional knowledge, skills, and abilities required include:

- ? Thorough knowledge of applicable law enforcement principles, practices, methods and equipment.
- ? Thorough knowledge of the physical layout of an airport or related facilities
- ? Thorough knowledge of administrative, budget, purchasing, and personnel systems.
- ? Skill in the use of firearms and other police equipment and in the application of self-defense tactics
- ? Ability to effectively and efficiently manage a department including administrative and supervisory functions.
- ? Ability to establish authority, to lead, and to inspire confidence among subordinate officers; skill in counseling, coaching, motivation, communication, and performance management with subordinates.
- ? Ability to act with sound judgment in both routine and emergency situations.
- ? Ability to plan and direct special programs and events related to law enforcement.
- ? Ability to adjust to continuously changing security directives as mandated by federal requirements.
- ? Ability to prepare clear and concise activity reports.
- ? Ability to build and maintain cooperative and effective relations with the public and other law enforcement or governing agencies.

Applicants with an equivalent combination of education and experience will be considered.

Salary is commensurate with education and experience.
